Nursery

Nursery is provided for young children up to 2 years of age each Sunday

Sunday School & Children's Church

Sunday school classes are available for children aged 2 to Grade 9. Classes are held after the passing of the peace, children meet in the church hall for music and worship before heading to their classrooms.

Children's Church is a combined Sunday school class for children in JK to Grade 6, and is offered on holiday Sundays and through the summer. Regular classes continue to be available for children ages 2-3 years.

Joyful Noise Children's Praise Ministry

Children meet in the Choir Room after the church service for 30 minutes to learn new praise and worship songs. Regular attendance is encouraged. All children are welcome to participate.

Who: Children in Grades 1-3
When: Every 1st and 3rd Thursday of the month from September to June.
Time: 6:00 – 7:30 p.m.

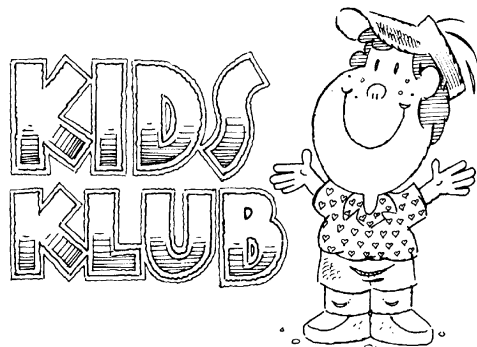
Who: Children in Grades 4-6
When: Every 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month from September to June.
Time: 6:00 – 7:30 p.m.
What: We learn about God and grow in our faith while having lots of fun. We start by sharing a meal together. Following dinner, we play games, make crafts and sing songs, all centered on the bible lesson.



Who: Children 2-3 years of age and children in junior & senior kindergarten
When: Every 1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month, from September to June.



Time: 6:30 – 7:30 p.m.
What: We learn about God through engaging and interactive storytelling. Bible learning is enhanced through games, crafts, songs and even snacks!



Who: All children from Grade 1 to Grade 6 are invited to participate. Activities are often open to their families as well. We encourage children to invite their friends.
When: Once a month, usually on the 3rd Saturday, from September to June, Times will vary.
What: Awesome activities, sometimes off-site. Activities may include movie matinees, sledding, field trips, etc.
