The Crucifixion of Christ Stained Glass

The stained glass depiction of Christ on the cross was done in 2016 by John McDonald. The cross is the most recognized icon in the world. The cross in this piece of art is composed of 3 colours of glass to represent the Trinity. The sun is a powerful symbol of the resurrection of Jesus and the rainbow is the representation of hope and the covenant given by God to Noah. The white shows purity and reminds us that Jesus shed His blood to cleanse our sins.

This beautiful symbol of the death of Jesus will remain a centre focus for us as we begin the season of Lent, a time for us to prepare for the glorious resurrection of Jesus on Easter Sunday. It will be displayed here until Good Friday.



As we enter the time of Lent let's remind ourselves of the goals of Lent:

- 1. It is a time to Remember what the Lord did for us.
- 2. It is a time to Repent, or Re-orient ourselves to the Lord by adding/ changing at least one habit.
- 3. It is a time for Retraining ourselves to follow our goals and changes.
- 4. It is a time for Retaining and Maintaining what we've learned long after Lent ends.
- Remember, Lent is not a period of deprivation but rather a period of growth, with the rest of the year being maintenance of that growth.
