

Accessibility Workshop March 4, 2018

Have you ever wondered the best way to help a person with a disability or how to ensure that everyone feels included and welcome? If you have not yet attended this workshop and you contribute to the life and work of this congregation as greeters, ushers, group leaders, elders, members of the board of managers, Kidzone helpers/teachers, nursery volunteers, Alpha leaders, coffee servers, staff or VBS helpers, plan to come to the workshop on Sunday March 4 after the morning worship service. The 2 hour workshop is open to everyone and there is no charge. A light lunch is included so please let Timothy or Lyanne know if you plan to attend.

The Refugee Committee is pleased to announce that the family we wish to sponsor in partnership with the Saliba family had a meeting at the Canadian Embassy in Jordan on Thursday, January 25th. This meeting was to determine their eligibility as refugees and admissibility into Canada. The family has been accepted to come to Canada on a preliminary basis, pending results from upcoming security checks and medical examinations. This process could take another five to six months. We praise God that our application has been successful and that it took 15 months after submitting the initial application to get to this point, which is faster than the 20 month average. We would like to extend our thanks to MP, Bryan May and his staff for looking into the status of our application during the fall of last year.
