Rachel's Home Needs Your Help!



Our international mission is to support Rachel's Home, a Christian HIV/AIDS orphanage and community school in Maputsoe, Lesotho, in Southern Africa. For more than 10 years you have been very faithful and generous in showing your love and caring for all our orphans.

Recently the house, where the orphans sleep and where food is prepared and stored, suffered extensive damage from a severe hailstorm. We are so thankful that no one was injured.

Hilda, the amazing house-mother who runs the orphanage, had the roof repaired but cannot afford to fix the ceiling below. She has sent us a quote for ~\$3500 to make the repairs.

It is an emergency situation because Lesotho is in the fall season with present night time temperatures in the 5-8° C range. However the winter months of June, July and August are coming and are considerably colder with some snow. There is **NO** heat source in this house.

At Session this past week the Board of Managers generously offered to give us a short-term loan for \$2500. We would use \$1000 from the current Lesotho account which would be replaced with later fundraising. We are appealing for your help to repay the \$2500 to the Board of Managers. Envelopes are available at the table in the front of the church and at the kitchen window where coffee is served.

If more funds are donated than needed, these would remain with Rachel's Home. We are also obtaining a quote to perhaps place some insulation above the ceiling. Please prayerfully consider if you can help and pray that repairs can be made as soon as possible.
