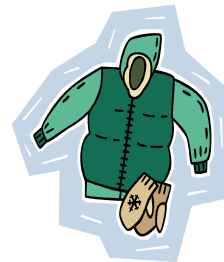


Please continue to support the Cambridge Self-Help Food Bank by placing donations in the baskets in the front foyer.
