The Marriage Course

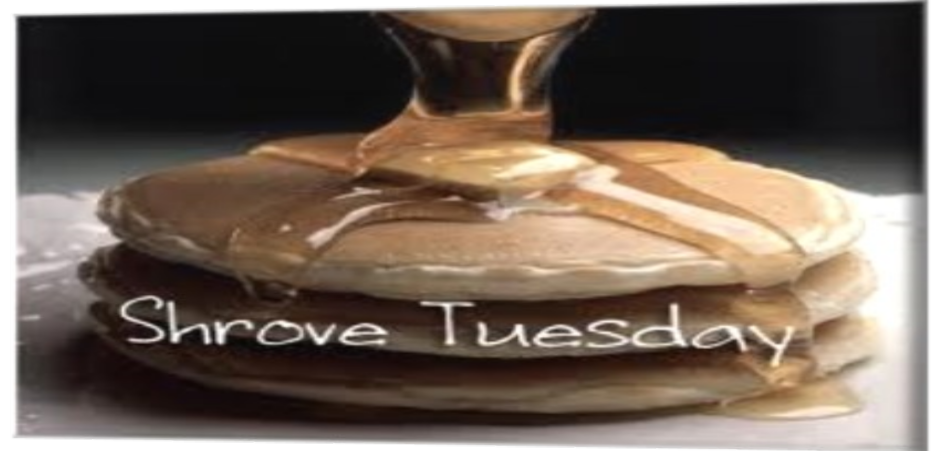
When: April 25th, 2019 @ 7pm
