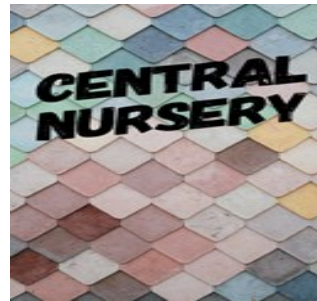
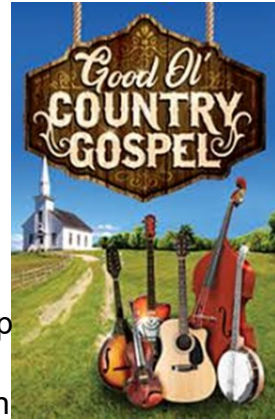
If you use Pre Authorized Remittance or E-Transfer please then consider multiplying your monthly giving by 1.15 for example \$300 x 1.15 = \$345.
