In the summertime, this isn’t such a tough arrangement. However, winter is just around the corner. Snow and cold may not necessarily be something that comes immediately to mind when thinking about Africa, but they are common in the winter months in Lesotho.

Imagine trying to prepare meals for 20 children outdoors in winter! There are days when, due to wind and snow, it’s simply impossible. The alternative gas cook stove is terrifyingly unsafe. This must change.

So Central, let’s make a real difference. Our goal is to raise \$1,200 to purchase and install a new stove in the kitchen of the orphanage. We can make this happen!
