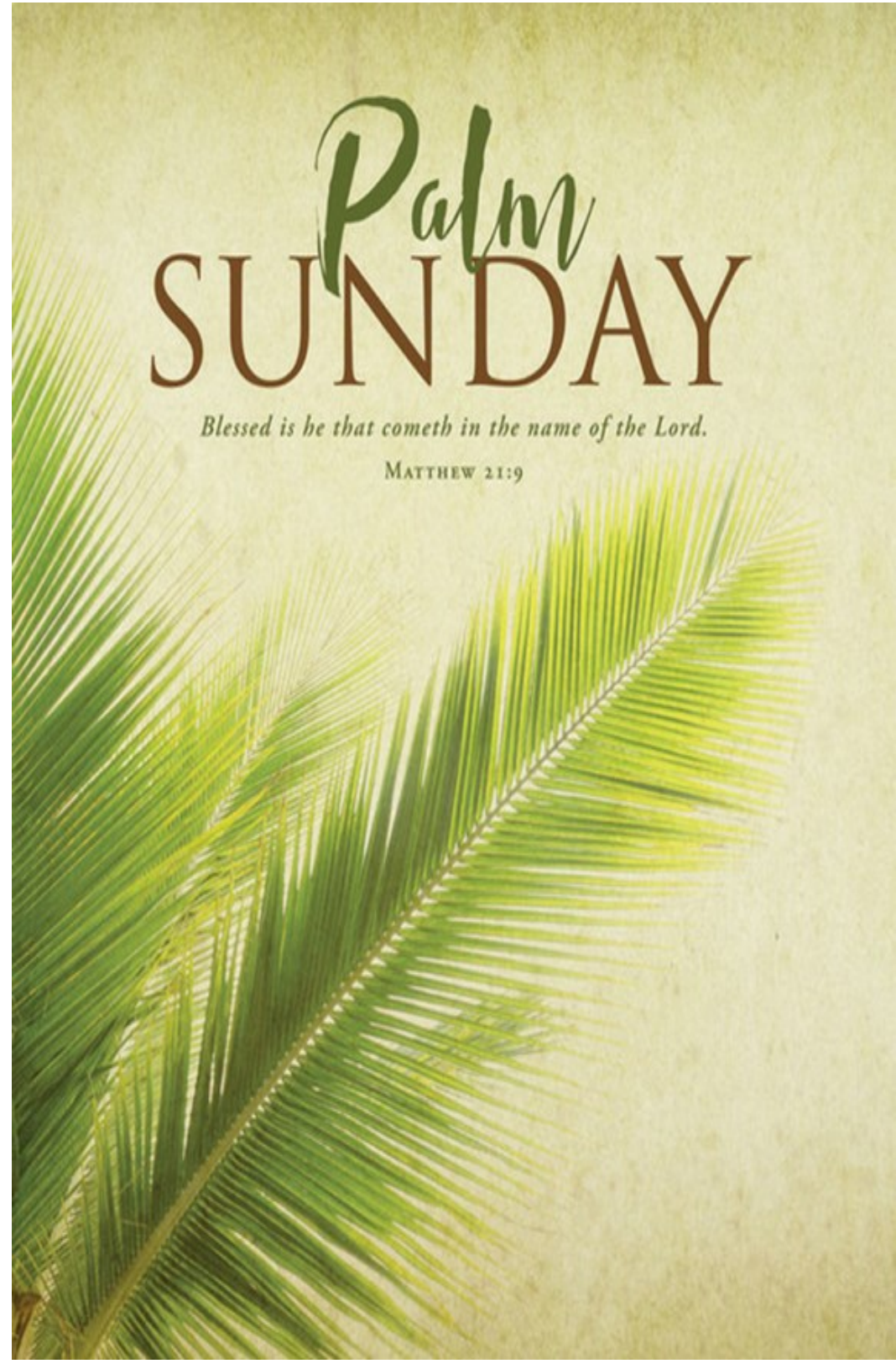

April 2019

- **Minister in Association:** After his retirement, the Rev. Dr. Wayne Dawes and his wife, Mafalda, attended Central and Wayne graciously assisted us as needed as our Minister in Association. - **Adopt-a-project:** As part of our Stewardship Plan, we invited the congregation to use their skills and talents to adopt a project to improve our church. Our first project was the parlour and we thank Barbara Barrie for taking this on. The newly painted window frames, the window blinds, new lighting and refinished floor have really made a difference in the room which is brighter, more inviting and more functional.
