

WHO DOES WHAT?

Session: The Session is responsible for overseeing all groups and activities that take place within the congregation including Christian Education, children's and youth programs, adult groups, missions, outreach, some aspects of worship, stewardship and pastoral care for everyone in the congregation. Members of session are elected by the congregation and ordained as ruling elders.

Board of Managers: The Board of Managers is responsible for keeping the building and other property in good condition and for managing the finances and keeping financial records. Members of the Board are elected by the congregation.

Trustees: As required by law in Ontario, trustees are people who represent the congregation in legal matters. For example, if the congregation were to take out a mortgage, the trustees would sign on behalf of the congregation. Trustees are appointed by the congregation.
