Keep in mind that the machine in the kitchen is a sanitizer, not a dishwasher and that dishes have to be washed before being placed in the machine. Public Health makes frequent surprise inspections of church kitchens and we want to make sure that everything is in order.
- **Central Cares:** Central does a lot to help those in need in our community and in Lesotho. We also want to make sure that people in our congregation are given a helping hand when the need arises. We now have a list of people who will prepare meals or provide rides in times of need. The list is in the office and we want to thank everyone who volunteered to be on the lists and Jan Sparrow who did the work to organize the lists. Denise McClellan and Sandy Barrie are looking after Central Cares.
