• **Retirements:** George Barrie and Andrew Foster have retired from active service as elders. We sincerely thank both men for their hard work and faithful service to this congregation.

• **Bequest:** With gratitude, we have received a bequest from the estate of the late David Aikin in the amount of \$35,723.03. David and his wife Janice were both elders at Central. We very much appreciate this bequest and will ensure that a suitable use is identified.

• New website: Central's website has been completely redesigned and is scheduled to go live in the next few days. We very much appreciate the contributions made by Mike Jennings and Matt Williams both of whom donated their professional expertise and time, and by Greg Gowing our resident webmaster who worked tirelessly on the project. • **Christmas Eve:** A total of 255 people attended the two services on Christmas Eve. A big thank you goes out to everyone who worked so hard to ensure that our first evening with two services went so smoothly.

• **Covid and Central:** The new provincial restrictions allow churches to conduct worship services, baptisms, weddings and funerals at 50% capacity. All other activities are limited to 5 people indoors and 10 people outdoors. We will continue to hold both in-person (including Kidzone) and online services on Sunday mornings. Mid-week youth programs will make adjustments based on the new limits. All Covid protocols will be in place for in-person services.
