Communion Services: We will have Communion Services on February 11 (Sunday before Lent begins), May 5, June 16, Oct. 6 (World Communion Sunday) and December 1 (first Sunday in Advent)

Aubrey Away: Aubrey will be travelling to South Africa to see his mother and will be away from February 12 to 23. Jim Hetherington will lead our worship services on February 18 and 25.

Meeting with Youth and Young Adults: The session is planning an informal evening with the youth and young adults of our congregation to answer their questions and hear their ideas.

Summer Student Interns: We have submitted an application for a federal government grant to hire eight summer student interns and a student supervisor for this summer. These positions are open to young people from the age of 15 to 30 and are primarily intended to provide work experience for young people entering the workforce for the first time. We will hear if our application has been approved later in the spring. If it is approved, the application process will be publicized. Hymn Sing Cafe: Approximately 6 times per year we host a free afternoon to sing classic hymns accompanied by the organ, followed by a social time with refreshments.
