**Central to Host a Sunday Supper and Service
for Local Migrant Farm Workers**

Alejandro Ortiz, a member of our Missions Team, has joined together with Pastor Julio from a Baptist Church in Stratford, to establish an outreach program for some of our local migrant farm workers. Canada is blessed to have these men come to Canada from Mexico and Guatemala to work in our local fields and greenhouses. They often need to leave their families and friends for several months each year.

Hosting an event for this outreach program offers us an opportunity to show our appreciation to these workers by offering some joy, fellowship, and Christian teaching on their only day off in the week. Transportation is provided for the men from the farms to come to local parks to play soccer games and then attend a local church that provides a Sunday supper and service. Our Missions Team would like to host a soccer game at Churchill Park on Sunday July 13 and then invite the men to a supper and service at Central after the game.

Alejandro and Pastor Julio will provide the service in Spanish, and the Missions Team will organize the supper for them. Help us welcome our new friends to Canada.

How can you help us? There is a clipboard with a sign-up sheet on the table at the front entrance to church.

1. Donate to purchase a salad or a dessert for the supper on July 13.
2. Donate to help cover the cost of the hamburgers, buns, and other supplies for the supper.
