**Let's not get scammed:** Recently a scam email supposedly from Aubrey went out to some people in the congregation.

Please remember that any email from Aubrey would come from "[Aubrey@cpcmail.ca](mailto:Aubrey@cpcmail.ca)". He would not send out an email asking for help in this way and he *never* signs his name as Pastor or Reverend Aubrey. We are going to host an anti-scam/anti-fraud seminar in the fall.

• **Applying for Grants:** The Presbyterian Church in Canada has a number of grants which we can apply for. Grant writing is an art. We would love some help from anyone in the congregation who has experience writing grant proposals. If you can help, please speak to any elder.
